Over the past decade, the U.S. has seen an increase in the number of high-magnitude storm events causing massive destruction and an increase in sea level rise. Hurricanes Katrina, Irene and Sandy left expansive areas of death, devastation and an increasing need to build risk reduction infrastructure and resilience among coastline communities. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) North Atlantic Division joined officials from public and private sectors in a year-long comprehensive study to develop a framework for diminishing coastal storm damage.

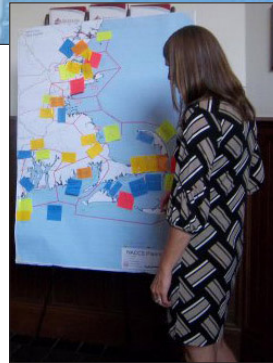
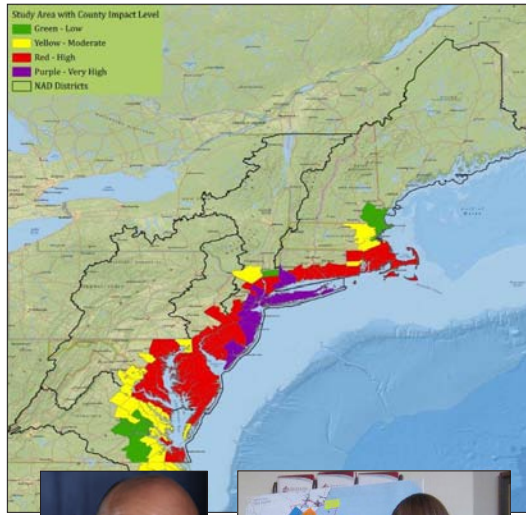
