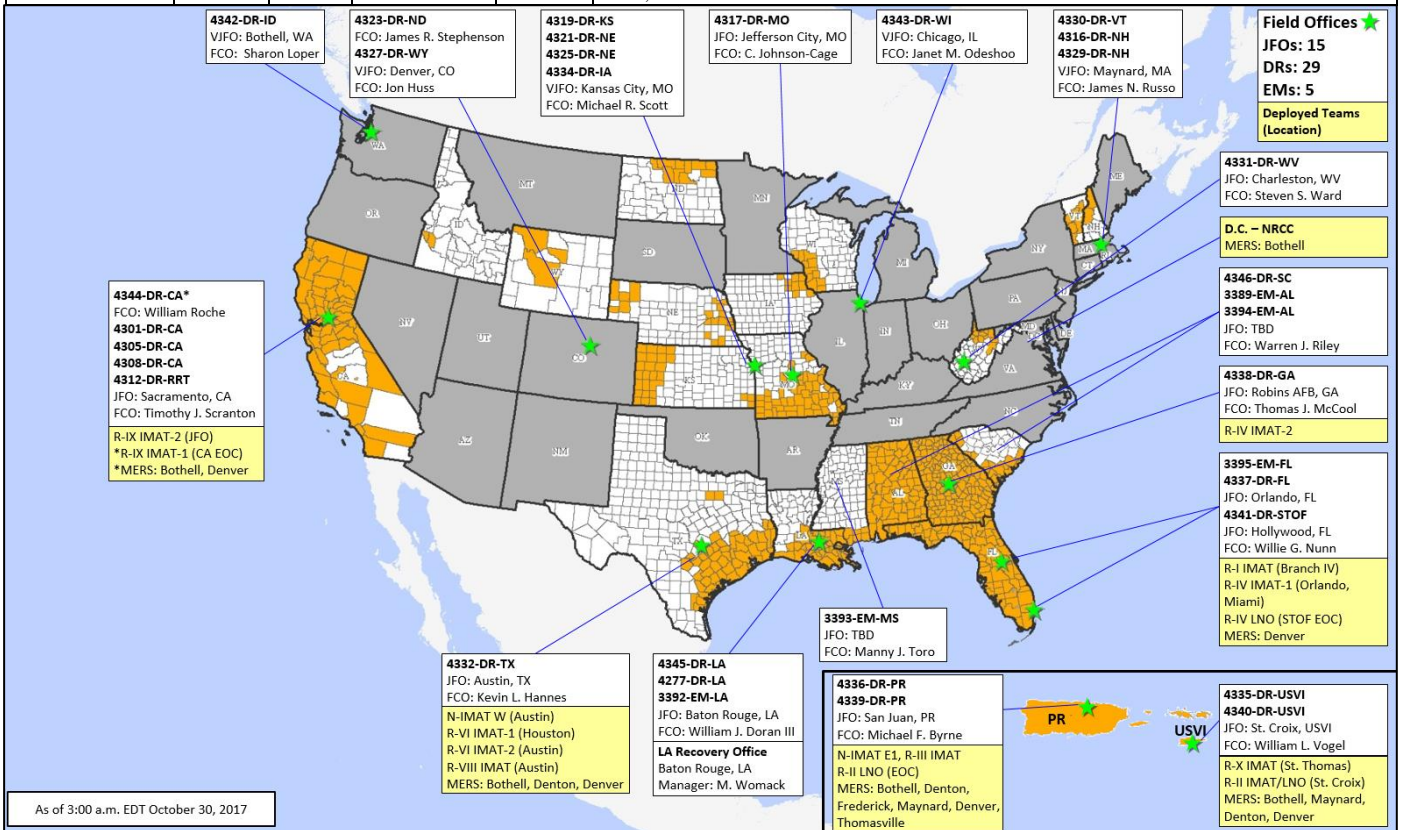

## **Current Operations**

### **PR/USVI Updates**

**Situation:** Life safety, life sustainment, and recovery efforts ongoing in PR and the USVI

### **Shelters/Population:**

- **PR:** 77 (NC) / 3,502 (-75)
- **USVI:** 5 (NC) / 187 (NC)

### **Power Outages / Restoration:**

- **PR:** 29.7% customer power restored; PREPA estimates 95% service restored by Dec 15
- **USVI customer power from grid:** St. Thomas: 31.4%; St. Croix: 3.3%; St. John: Unknown percentage
  - WAPA estimates 90% of service restored by late Dec

### **Communications:**

- **PR:** 40.6% of cell towers operational; 86% of population with voice and text coverage
- **USVI:** 60.3% of cell towers operational; 88% of population with voice and text coverage

### **Water:**

- **PR:** 80% (+5%) have potable water; 89 of 114 Drinking Water Filtration Plants are operating
- **USVI:** Boil Water Advisory remains in effect

### **FEMA Response:**

- NRCC: Modified Level III – day shift (8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. EDT, Mon-Sat); NWC: Steady State
- Crisis Action Planning Team activated (Transportation and Transitional Sheltering)

**Territory Response:** PR and USVI EOCs at Full Activation

**Joint Preliminary Damage Assessments:** None

## **Monitoring / Potential Future Operations**

### **Severe Weather Northeast and Mid-Atlantic**

Situation: High winds, heavy rainfall with a potential of flash flooding continues. Wind gusts up to 60 mph and coastal flooding possible

- Power Outages: 752.5K customers out across FEMA Regions I, II, & III (*DOE EAGLE-1 as of 2:00 a.m. EDT*)
- Damages to structures will be evaluated during the day. No reports of significant damage at this time
- Downed trees and debris caused local road closures
- NH & NY EOC at Partial Activation for Severe Weather
- FEMA Region I, II, & III remain at Normal Operations
- FEMA NWC at Steady State

### **Tropical Cyclones:**

**Atlantic:** Tropical Storm Philippe dissipated; No new tropical cyclones expected during the next 48 hours

**Eastern Pacific:** No new tropical cyclones expected during the next 48 hours

**Central Pacific:** No new tropical cyclones expected during the next 48 hours

**Significant Weather:** Marginal to Slight risk for Flash Flooding across portions of ME

**Space Weather:** Nothing Significant to Report

**Wildfires:** Nothing Significant to Report

**Earthquakes:** No significant activity
