### **Operational Updates**

#### Texas:

CPCB, Housing, and NCR RSFs participated in a meeting with EPA Urban Waters program to discuss support of Harvey-impacted communities. CPCB staff also supported the Infrastructure RSF at the Texas Coastal Resiliency Master Plan meeting at Corpus Christi; presented at the Region 6 Federal Executive Board meeting to discuss regional interagency coordination; participated on a Recovery Symposium panel concerning building recovery partner relationships; and engaged in the Disaster Strike Team in Aransas County. The team has begun outreach to councils of government. CPCB Teams continue to refine their neighborhood analysis tool to roll out in mid-December.

#### Florida:

CPCB Florida staff have completed the draft Recovery Support Strategy and have submitted it to leadership and other teams. Each Recovery Support Function (RSF) illustrated in the document will focus on Federal and State Community Placed Based Recovery. CPCB Florida staff have also continued to coordinate with communities. Monroe County had its kickoff meeting on Tuesday. Efforts on the Recovery Symposium continue, a Tier III Symposium Coordination Work Plan is under review. CPCB Florida staff hope to develop a Florida Mission Planning Management tool and embed Community Placed Based Recovery Teams within the counties in the new couple of weeks.

# **Operational Updates**

#### **U.S. Virgin Islands:**

This week, the Community Planning and Capacity Building (CPCB) Virgin Island Field Coordinator and the Federal Disaster Recovery Coordinator actively participated in the first in-person Virgin Islands Governors Recovery Taskforce meeting. The CPCB Field Coordinator is working to ensure that all Recovery Support Functions and FEMA program areas are incorporated into various committees associated with the Taskforce and that Recovery Support Strategy is aligned with Taskforce priorities.

Scoping of a modified Community Planning Technical Assistance program is being carried out with both the St. Croix Foundation and St. John Community Foundation and will be refined through the end of the year with expected deployment of Staff in early 2018.

CPCB is supporting the development of a model code guidebook for both homeowners and local architects/engineers with input from FEMA Hazard Mitigation, Natural and Cultural Resources RSF, and community groups.

#### **Puerto Rico**

In Puerto Rico, CPCB has connected with the director of the planning school at University of Puerto Rico and with networks representing multiple community groups. CPCB has exchanging plans and developed approaches to coordinate with the Resilient Puerto Rico Commission. Resilience efforts continue through coordination with the Rockefeller, Ford, and Open Society Foundations. CPCB Puerto Rico plans to meet next week with the Center for a New Economy, AECOM's lead on technical support, and with a representative from Rockefeller's 100 Resilient Cities.
