Mitigation Planning and the Community Rating System

The Federal Emergency Management Agency has two hazard mitigation planning programs that help communities design the best way to reduce their flood risk: local multi-hazard mitigation planning associated with the Stafford Act, and floodplain management planning under the Community Rating System (CRS). The programs often involve similar goals, information, and stakeholders, but they are often managed as separate processes. This does not have to be the case. In fact, communities can get more bang for their buck by combining these processes and developing one plan that meets the goals and requirements of both programs.
